To borrow money

Special Provision of Emergency Small Loans
(kinkyu koguchi tokurei kashitsuke)

● You can borrow up to 100,000 yen. You pay it back within 2 years. No interest.
※ Those who are in particular need can borrow up to 200,000 yen.

Special Provision of Comprehensive Support Fund
(sogo shien shikin tokurei kashitsuke)

● Household of two persons or more can borrow 200,000 yen a month, and single person household can borrow 150,000 yen a month, both for a period of up to 3 months. You pay it back within 10 years. No interest.

● You can receive the subsidy to cover part of the leave allowance for your employees if your sales dropped and had to ask your employees to take a leave. ※ You can receive the whole amount of the leave allowance if you meet certain criteria

Registration of Birth (syusyo todoke)

- If a baby is born between Jan. 31 and June 30, 2020, you don't have to rush to submit documents to the Immigration. Please submit documents to the Immigration by "61 days plus 3 months" after the birth.

- If you came to Japan for working holiday but cannot go back to your country, you can continue to stay for working holiday.

▶ Visa Renewal

● If your period of stay on your residence card expires between March 1 and July 31, 2020, and if you want to continue to stay in Japan, you can submit the documents within 3 months after the period of stay expires.

※ If you have designated activities visa or departure preparation period, please go to the Immigration before the period of stay expires.

● Usually, those who are changing their visa status or renewing their period of stay are required to receive the result of their application within 2 months after the period of stay. But, now, it is OK for you to receive the result within 3 months after the period of stay.

Foreign Students

▶ You cannot go home.

● If you graduated on Jan. 1 or afterward, and cannot go home, you can be granted designated activities visa (6 months). You can work up to 28 hours per week.

Technical Intern Trainee

▶ Technical Intern Trainee

● If you are a trainee who cannot go home, you can continue the training program. If not, you can work in other job places as designated activities (6 months).

● If you are a trainee who cannot go home, but do not want to work anymore, you can be granted designated activities visa.

● If you are a trainee, and cannot take the skills test, or are planning to change to category 1, specified skilled worker, you can change your visa to designated activities (4 months, can work).

You lost your job, were fired, made to work less days or laid off.

▶ Workers

● If you were fired, laid off, or your contract was terminated or your work days or hours were reduced, you can continue to stay in Japan with your current visa status. If you want to work longer, you can do so by applying the "Permission to Engage in Activity other than that Permitted under the Status of Residence Previously Granted".

● If your current visa expires, you can continue to work by changing your visa to the designated activities visa.
